The Florida Department of Health (DOH) manages the Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMSC) Advisory Committee established in section 401.245(5), Florida Statutes. The EMSC Advisory Committee makes specific recommendations to the State Surgeon General to ensure the goal of reducing child and youth mortality and morbidity caused by severe illness or trauma. Meetings are generally held in conjunction with Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council and occur quarterly. Additional mid- quarter conference calls will also take place for all committee members. Appointed committee members are expected to attend a minimum of six meetings per calendar year.
